BOROUGH RATIFYING AND CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE

ADVISORY QUESTION NO. 1

Advisory Vote On The Idea Of Consolidating Governments

Should the Kodiak Island Borough pursue the idea of consolidating the Kodiak Island Borough and the City of Kodiak into a single unit of government?

WHEREAS, the ballot proposition below was presented to Service Area No. 1 voters and to voters who are registered in the area proposed to be added to Service Area No. 1.

BALLOT PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the boundary of Service Area No. 1 be altered by the addition of Lot 6 and Lot 7A of Block 5, and Lot 1, Lot 2 and Lot 3 of Block 6 Monashka Bay Subdivision and Tract B Miller Point Alaska Subdivision, which will result in Kodiak Island Borough taking ownership of Otmeloi Way from the State of Alaska if the roadway is improved, and assume responsibility for ongoing maintenance and upkeep of Otmeloi Way via Service Area No. 1?
