Contractor/Resident Dumpster Use

To whom it may concern,

All dumpsters under contract with Alaska Waste are sole purpose dumpsters. If a dumpster is rented for construction/demolition debris (C&D) it can only be used for the C&D materials. Any C&D load that is greater than 10% metal will not be accepted at the Kodiak Island Borough (KIB) Landfill (refer to Page 4 line 11 of the Kodiak Island Borough Fee Schedule). If a sole purpose dumpster is delivered to the KIB Landfill with a mixed load (containing more than 1 type of waste material) that dumpster would not be following borough code. No one may do the following per Borough Code 8.25.180 Baler Facility and Sanitary Landfill B.4, "Dispose of any material in an area other than a designated area. [Ord. FY2010-07 §3, 2010]." Sole purpose dumpsters are an extension of the designated areas at the KIB Landfill. The mixed load could not be properly categorized or disposed of due to having mixed material. Some examples of mixed loads are: C&D with municipal solid waste (household trash), metals with municipal solid waste, C&D with over 10% of metal. Dumpsters that are not properly being used for their contracted sole purpose will be turned away and must be sorted appropriately by the contractor/resident before returning to the KIB Landfill for disposal.

A **\$750.00 fee** for the misuse (explained above) of a rented dumpster has been established and will be enforced (refer to Page 4 of the Kodiak Island Borough Fee Schedule). The renting party will be held responsible for this fee.
